DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,764, dated February 2, 1904.

Application filed January 6, 1904. Serial No. 187,986. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANDRÉ BUSTANOBY, a citizen of the United States, residing in the borough of Manhattan, city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification.

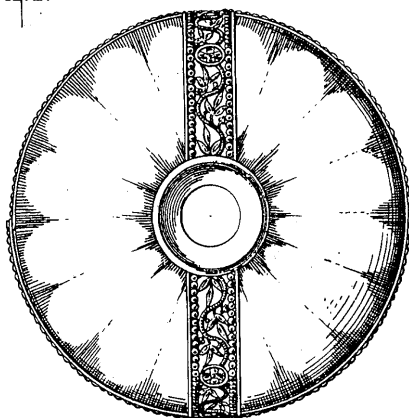
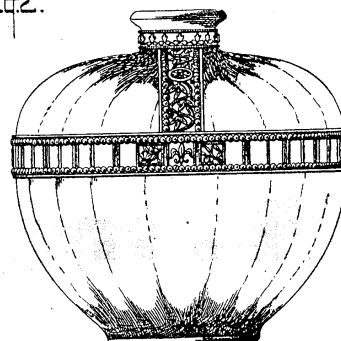
